Conditions for participation:

Participants from Germany need the DTU Passport. International competitors need to have a valid registration with their countries Member National Assosiation.

All participants have to proof their age and nationality by presenting their valid passport or identification card at registration. Those who are not recognized as adults by law in their own country must submit a written consent signed by parents or lawful guardians accepting the participation and all parts of the official invitation (liability declaration).

Each competitor may only start for his own nation.

By registering, the participants accept the NADA Code in its current version and submit to the application of the anti doping regulations by registering for and participating at this tournament. More information can be found at www.nada.de.

Uniform:

All athletes from 1. st Poom / DAN must have a WT-approved Poomsae competition uniform.

Mini Division (Ages 8-11): White Dobok or white top with red and black collar, blue pants for males; the same top, but with red pants, for females.

<u>Cadet Division (Ages 12-14):</u> White top with red and black collar, blue pants for males; the same top, but with red pants, for females.

Junior and Senior Division (Ages 15-50): White top with dark blue pants for males: white top with light blue pants for females

for males; white top with light blue pants for females.

<u>Master Division (Ages 51 and older):</u> Yellow top and dark blue pant for both males and females.

Results:

Each participant agrees with the registration that his first name, name, age group, nation, club and placement are published in the result lists online and/or in print. By registering, all participants also agree that their image may be published as a photo or film footage and/or their name in reports that appear in any media during or after the tournament.

Protest: Only the official coach is allowed to protest after 10 minutes of the

pertinent contest. The protest is € 100,-- which has to be paid

immediately to the referee director.

recognized in the country-score.

Trophies for places 1 - 5 for clubs, Trophies for places 1 - 5 for nations.

General Information for

Recognized Poomsae: Cut off system.

Every running poomsae will be drawn by lot.

In each competition, different poomsae will be performed.

Achieved points from the rounds before will not be carried over to the next round.

The poomsae have to be presented in the same order as they were drawn.

After the first poomsae (the waiting period between 1st and 2nd Poomsae is minimum of 30 seconds) the athlete has to start with the second one.

In case there is a tied score after the completion of the final round on the rank 1, 2, 3 or 4, the contestant who is awarded more points in presentation shall be declared the winner. In case the score is still tied, the contestant with the highest total points (including the highest and lowest points) wins. If it's still tied the referee will decide on a poomsae to be performed.

The organizer reserves the right to reduce the number of poomsae to be performed in the preliminary and the semi final round to one (1) poomsae. In the final two poomsae are presented.

Drawing:

The recognized poomsae for each category will be drawn by the competition board. They will be published on 14.02.2020 on www.GOP2020.de.

General Information for

Free Style Poomsae:

Free Style Poomsae is the performance based on taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography. Music and choreography shall be the choice of the contestant. The duration of the contest is from 90 to 100 seconds.

Points of mandatory foot techniques shall be awarded only if athletes perform the techniques in the given order as below:

- Heights of jump
- Number of kicks in a jump
- Gradient of spins in a spin kick
- Performance level of consecutive kicks
- Acrobatic actions

Performed techniques must be within the boundary of taekwondo.

In Free Style Competition you perform only one Poomsae.

Music:

During registration time on Friday and Saturday, you can submit your music in MP3 format indicating your name and class.

Para Poomsae:

Cut off system. Every poomsae is free choice. Two poomsae in the final round without deduction or bonus points.

All participants in the para divisions must show a medical certificate to prove their disability at the registration. This certificate can be issued in German or English language. If the participant is in possesion of a disabled ID card, it needs to be shown as well. INAS Master List is accepted by number.

Division P 10: Visual Impairments

Division P 11: Visual acuity poorer than LogMAR 2.6.

Division P 12: Visual acuity ranging from LogMAR 1.5 to 2.6 (inclusive) and/or Visual

field constricted to a diameter of less than 6 degrees.

Division P 13: Visual acuity ranging from LogMAR 1.4 to 1.0 (inclusive) and/or Visual

field constricted to a diameter of less than 20 degrees.

Division P 20: Intellectually Impaired

Division P 30: Physical Impairment

Division P 31: Mild, bilateral (or affecting 3 limbs) spasticity, ataxia, athetosis or

dystonia.

Division P 32: Dyskinesia, dystonia, ataxia, spasticity or athetosis affecting all 4

limbs.

Division P 33: Unilateral spasticity (arm and leg), spastic hemidystonia.

Division P 34: Very mild unilateral (one arm and leg on same side) or bilateral

spasticity, mild athetosis, dyskinesia, dystonia or ataxia (less than 25

percent in duration and maximum).

Division P 36: Impairment on the arms that cannot be classified in the P31-34.
