

CONTEST TIME

Recognized Poomsae

Individual, Pair, and Team competitions up to 90 seconds. The waiting period time between 1st poomsae and 2nd poomsae is minimum 30 seconds.

Free Style Poomsae

Individual, Pair, and Mixed Team competitions from 90 seconds to 100 seconds.

The WT Technical delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as he sees fit.

Para Poomsae

Individual competitions up to 120 seconds. The waiting period time between 1st poomsae and 2nd poomsae is minimum 60 seconds.

COMPETITION RULES

WT Poomsae Competition Rules & Interpretation (May 14, 2019).

PARA POOMSAE:

The latest updated World Para Taekwondo Poomsae Competition Rules will be implemented for competition in the Poomsae Sport Classes.

Article 9.1 will be used for competition for All Sport Classes there is a free choice to athletes to choose (1) Poomsae from Group 1 and (1) Poomsae from Group 2 for each round.



FREESTYLE POOMSAE

All Freestyle medal events: final round

*Cut-off system:

The organization can change this due to organizational matters.

*Music freestyle:

Athletes must bring their music (sound without lyrics/words) in MP3 format on USB-stick. Apple audio format is not allowed. The music and choreography shall be the choice of the contestant. It should NOT contain any political, social and religious or any contents that may harm, discriminate or offend others.

** Freestyle music:

Should be submitted at the Head of team Meeting with the following details:

- 1) On the USB, each digital file should contain:
 - A. Name of the country
 - B. Name of the category
 - C. Name of the athlete/athletes

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Contestants may compete in <u>maximum two (2) medal</u> events

Recognized Poomsae and/or Freestyle Poomsae competition unless he or she is limited by gender or age. Example: max. 2 Recognized Poomsae medal events or max. 2 Freestyle Poomsae medal events, or one (1) medal event in Recognized Poomsae and Freestyle Poomsae

- 1. Holder of a valid 2023 WT Global Athlete License
- A participant of must be a member of a pertinent Member National Association, recognized by Europe Taekwondo Union or World Taekwondo. (Only National Teams)
- Para: A participant of must be a member of a pertinent Member National Association, recognized by Europe Taekwondo Union or World













Taekwondo. (Open for National Teams / Clubs)

- Holder of the nationality of the participant team. 4.
- European Poomsae: 1St Dan/Poom, and above-5. **WT** regulations
- European Para Poomsae: 4th Geup and above 6.

AGE ELIGIBILITY

European Poomsae: Born 2011 or before Born 2005 or before **European Para Poomsae:**

- The age limits for each division are based on the year, not the birthday date.
- All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification card.
- For those athletes that are not adults, a written consent must be submitted (please find enclosed on the last pages) at the registration, signed by one of the parents or legal guardians, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The eligibility requirements for coaches are as follows:

- 1. Minimum age of 18 years
- 2. Holder of a valid 2023 WT Global Official License
- 3. Coaching is not allowed wearing Dobok & sandal
- Para WT coach certification 4

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

12 November 2023, 23:59 CET

This deadline is applicable for all sport entries, payments and admitting all required forms.

PROTEST FEE

200 euro which is non-refundable. Each team is responsible for submitting the protest in the proper manner and according to the applicable rules and regulations.













REPLACEMENT

Replacement of athletes, pairs or teams after the registration deadline is only possible until **21 November 2023**, **23:59 CET**. The following rules are applicable:

- Replacement can be done only if all entry fees and accommodation fees have been paid
- A fee of 75 euro is applicable.

ACCREDITATION FEES

25 euro for replacement and reprinting request per accreditation card

50 euro for each on-site <u>approved</u> additional requested accreditation card or on the top of the accreditation cards quotas.

PROOF OF PAYMENT REQUIREMENT

All teams are <u>required</u> to send proof of payment (copy of bank transfer) to <u>info@europeantaekwondounion.org</u> within (1) week after registration in Simply Compete._

European Taekwondo Union/Organizing Committee has the right to delete sport entries from teams that do not send proof of payment from the system in order for other













athletes to register and to prevent 'ghost athletes'.

Any athlete registering on-line who does not take part in the competition and who has not been removed from the entry list before the deadline (12 November 2023), is liable for paying his/her entry-fee in full. (For any athlete not presenting at registration, his/her team or official will be liable for ensuring full payment has been received, prior to the team's participation).

If a team does not show up at the event and has not requested a participation cancellation before the deadline, the federation will be invoiced to settle the payment of the entry fees in full (100%).

NO REFUND

Europe Taekwondo Union/ Organizing Committee does not refund entry fees paid.


ACCREDITATION CARD DISTRIBUTION

Registered teams only receive the athlete and officials accreditation cards if all financial obligations have been fulfilled. For all registered athletes, the entry fee must be paid before the accreditation cards will be distributed to the respective team.

Identification of NOC Code and Manufacturer

National flag shall be located between 3.5cm below the right shoulder line of upper garment. Flag size should be 10 cm width x 7 cm height.



NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic Committee abbreviation, and it shall be printed at the back of the upper garment of Poomsae competition uniform in black color and centered 12cm from the top line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana".



The number of manufacturer's identification (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be one per garment within 20cm² except at the location of the WT logo according to the related WT guidelines in force as of this event.













The end of the belt must be at least10cm or higher above the knee.









Para Poomsae Sport Classes & Eligibility

For the P20 Sport Class, Virtus International Eligibility is still recognized. There will be an Medical Daignostic Form (MDF) for P20. IQ test from verified psychologist will be required as well as medical report. If Atlanto-Axial Instability (AAI) is present with downs syndrome this needs to be noted too. MDF and IQ test, AAI is required to be uploaded to the WTCS.








































































































MEDICAL DIAGNOSTIC FORM (MDF) for K40, P20, P30, P50 & P70

The Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) is to be completed in English by the athlete's individual physician or physic therapist.

The completed form must be submitted a 15 October, 2023 before the athlete undergoes athlete evaluation. This applies to all athletes with a physical impairment competing in WT. Depending on the athlete's health condition and impairment, additional medical information is to be attached to this form (see page 2). Please consult the WT Classification rules for a list of eligible impairments and underlying health conditions for Kyorugi and Poomsae.

There will be separate MDFs for P20, P30, P50, P70 For the P20 Sport Classes a new system for eligibility will be introduced. There will be an "MDF" for P20. IQ test from verified psychologist will be required as well as medical report. If AAI is present with downs syndrome this needs to be noted too.

NOTE: Failure to submit MDF and medical information can lead to your athlete not being able to be classified and receiving a "Classification Not Complete", "CNC". The athlete will then not be able to compete at the event.

VIRTUS CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM P20 SPORT CLASS Intellectually Impaired (II) athletes require Virtus International Eligibility as seen on the Virtus Master List. https://www.virtus.sport/eligibility-master-list.

For the P20 Sport Class, Virtus International Eligibility is still recognized. A new system for eligibility will be introduced. There will be an "MDF" for P20. IQ test from verified psychologist will be required as well as medical report. If AAI is present with downs syndrome this needs to be noted too.

MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING

Applicable medical rules:

The WT Medical Code is applicable, which all MNA participating this event must comply.

Applicable doping rules:

The WT Anti-Doping Rules and the WADA Anti-Doping Code are applicable. Compulsory random doping tests will be conducted among all athletes. World Taekwondo and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the event.

Therapeutic Use Exemption:

Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and WADA Anti-Doping Code for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE













applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information.

ACCOMMODATION

Hotel accommodation

All athletes participating at the 16th European Poomsae Championships & 1st European Para Poomsae Championships 2023 shall mandatorily book their hotel accommodation via the Organizing Committee. Any member of the team that does not comply with this regulation shall prepay a fee of 100 euro to the OC to receive an Accreditation card.













TRANSPORTATION

For those teams that stay in the official hotel, the Organizing Committee offers the Innsbruck Welcome Card. This card enables people to use public transport. Teams can apply online before they come to Innsbruck for the Welcome Card to use public transport when they arrive at Innsbruck airport or Innsbruck main station. INDEMNITIES

It is the responsibility of each registering team to ensure that their athletes and team officials have filled out the indemnification forms correctly and have duly signed them, thereby indemnifying WT, ETU, the Organizing Committee and all other officials and athletes from any claims of injuries, losses or otherwise arising during participation at the 16th European Poomsae Championships & 1st European Para Poomsae Championships 2023 or any activities linked therewith.

It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure and guarantee that sufficient insurance coverage has been arranged for all athletes, team officials and other participants. Without sufficient insurance coverage, teams will not be allowed to compete.

Please fill out the Personal Indemnity Forms and return them to the Organization Committee before 12 November 2023. Each participant (athletes, team officials, etc.) must fill out the indemnification form.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

All participating athletes, coaches, team officials, technical officials and participants at ETU events shall have mandatorily an international medical insurance that covers medical care and in case of emergency, repatriation to the country of origin, valid on the days present in the host country of the event. ETU nor the Organizing Committee shall be responsible to cover any medical costs incurred for medical treatment before, on or during the competition or repatriation in the broadest sense of the word.













All relevant documents proving that such an insurance is present, including insurance policy papers, should be taken to the event in case a medical situation occurs.

Each MNA/Club, Team doctor or team medical staff must ensure their athletes and team officials have valid international health insurance that covers medical and emergency care at the designated hospitals in Austria before arrival to the venue.
